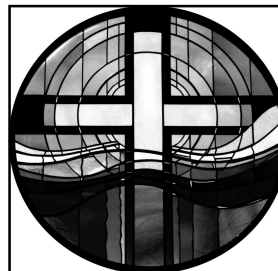

The influx is placing a huge strain on limited resources in a country struggling with climate change, food insecurity and underemployment. Pray for organisations such as Tearfund and BMS world mission, as they seek to support this desperately poor country.
- ✓ BMS world mission, asks us to give thanks that they are receiving growing interest from Asian churches to support BMS' work. Pray, that they will be able to help engage hearts for global mission in this region.
